2021 GENDER PAY GAP

This is Wren Kitchens gender pay gap report at the 'snapshot' date of 5 April 2021

The mean average pay of men was 5.3% higher than the mean average of women

We had a median pay gap of 9.3% between men and women

The mean average bonus awarded to men was 7.6% higher than the mean average for women

The median gap between bonuses paid for men and women was 1.7%

3.2% more women were awarded a bonus

Our gender distribution was 72.9% men and 27.1% women
